bbc radio 4 book of the week benjamin zephaniah who has travelled the world for his art and his humanitarianism now tells the one story that encompasses it all the story of his life in the early 1980s when punks and rastas were on the streets protesting about unemployment homelessness and the national front benjamin s poetry could be heard at demonstrations outside police stations and on the dance floor his mission was to take poetry everywhere and to popularise it by reaching people who didn t read books his poetry was political musical radical and relevant by the early 1990s benjamin had performed on every continent in the world a feat which he achieved in only one year and he hasn t stopped performing and touring since nelson mandela after hearing benjamin s tribute to him while he was in prison requested an introduction to the poet that grew into a lifelong relationship inspiring benjamin s work with children in south africa benjamin would also go on to be the first artist to record with the wailers after the death of bob marley in a musical tribute to nelson mandela the life and rhymes of benjamin zephaniah is a truly extraordinary life story which celebrates the power of poetry and the importance of pushing boundaries with the arts

an eye for an eye it s very simple you choose your homeland like a hyena picking and choosing where he steals his next meal from scavenger yes you grovel to the feet of mengistu and when his people spit at you and kick you from the bowl you scuttle across the border scavenger as a violent civil war rages back home teenager alem and his father are in a b b in berkshire it s his best holiday ever the next morning his father is gone and has left a note explaining that he and his mother

want to protect alem from the war this strange grey country of england is now his home on his own and in the hands of the social services and the refugee council he lives from letter to letter waiting to hear something from his father then alem meets car obsessed mustapha the lovely out of your league ruth and dangerous sweeney three unexpected allies who spur him on as alem fights to be seen as more than just the refugee boy based on the novel by benjamin zephaniah refugee boy is an urgent story of a courageous african boy sent to england to escape the violent civil war a story about arriving belonging and finding home

winner of the queen s knickers award 2024 to walk to to talk to to cry and rely on people will always need people from the creators of nature trail comes an uplifting picture book about the power of people and the importance of connecting with others this timely poem reminds us all to be kind to one another written by legendary poet benjamin zephaniah one of the times top 50 british post war writers beautifully illustrated by nila aye praise for nature trail a joy to read with small children independent

city psalms was benjamin zephaniah s first collection from bloodaxe back in 1992 it includes some of his best known poems including dis poetry money and us and dem best known for his performance poetry with a political edge for adults and his poetry with attitude for children zephaniah has his own rap reggae band he has produced numerous recordings including dub ranting 1982 rasta 1983 us and dem 1990 back to roots 1995 belly of de beast 1996 and naked 2004 he was the first person to record with the wailers after the death of bob marley in a musical tribute to nelson mandela which mandela heard while in prison on robben island their later meetings led to zephaniah working with children in south african townships and hosting the president s two nations concert at the royal albert hall in 1996 his first book of poems pen rhythm was produced in 1980 by a small east london publishing cooperative page one books his second collection the dread affair was published by hutchinson s short lived arena imprint in 1985 he has since published three collections with bloodaxe city psalms 1992 propa propaganda 1996 and too black too strong 2001 the latter including poems written while working with michael mansfield qc and other tooks barristers on the stephen lawrence case to do wid me

filmed by pamela robertson pearce bloodaxe books 2013 includes a full length feature film on dvd with all the poems performed on the film included in the book

the playful obstinate and courageously humorous tone of zephaniah s writing shines through hilarious and later heartbreaking guardian a teacher is dead murdered by two of his students in front of the whole school right in front of jackson jones but mr joseph was a good man people liked him respected him how could those boys stab him and jog away like nothing had happened unable to process what he has seen jackson begins his own investigation everyone knows who did it but as jackson uncovers more about the boys he becomes convinced that people need to understand why brilliantly written and with a real ear for dialogue fans of angie thomas and malorie blackman will love benjamin zephaniah s novels for young adult readers refugee boy face gangsta rap teacher s dead

a second irreverent collection of poetry for children touching on anything from vegetables to the queen and from sewage to the sun there s plenty of humour as well as poems on racism pollution and the murder of a cat

aimed primarily at children but doubtless appealing to some adults as well this collection of poems is aimed at the caring dedicated young vegans of this world as well as including 22 poems from the radical rapper and people s laureate the book also contains an extensive contact list of national and international vegan and animal rights organisations

rap along with benjamin zephaniah to the beat of his unique performance poetry poems taken mainly from the books talking turkeys and funky chickens

this innovative book takes an alternative look at 12 occupations and the people who fill them it s aim is to open up children s imaginations to the possibility that there are many more roles open to them than they may think it doesn t just simply depict male nurses female engineers and similar familiar stereotype busting examples but more broad ranging examples of unusual people doing unusual jobs such as sikh lollipop man a female clown and a black british space scientist benjamin

In 1668 a young Jamaican girl, Kemoshá, secures her freedom from enslavement and finds her true self while sailing to Panama with the legendary Captain Morgan. A junior library guild gold standard selection inspired by accounts of women pirates, this fantastical tale represents the era's cruelty without romanticizing it. Kemoshá's love and persistence combine with forceful action, the terror of harsh racism, and passionate, colourful language. The Toronto Star in 1668: fifteen-year-old Kemoshá is sold by a slave owner to a tavern keeper in Port Royal, Jamaica, the wickedest city on earth. She soon flees from a brutal assault and finds herself in the company of a mysterious free black man, Ravenhide, who teaches her the fine art of swordplay. He introduces her to her soul mate, Isabella, and helps her win her freedom. Ravenhide is a privateer for the notorious Captain Morgan aboard his infamous ship. The satisfaction at Ravenhide's encouragement, Morgan invites Kemoshá to join them on a pillaging voyage to Panama as her swashbuckling legend grows. She realizes she has the chance to earn enough to buy the freedom of her loved ones if she can escape with her life.

a poetic, gifty offering that combines first love, friendship, and persistent courage in this lyrical immigration story told in verse. Carrying just a suitcase and an old laundry bag filled with clothes, Kasienka and her mother are immigrating to England from Poland. Kasienka isn't the happiest girl in the world at home; her mother is suffering from a broken heart as she searches for Kasienka's father. And at school, Kasienka is having trouble being the new girl and making friends. The only time she feels

comforted is when she's swimming at the pool but she can't quite shake the feeling that she's sinking until a new boy swims into her life and she learns that there might be more than one way to stay afloat the weight of water is a coming of age story that deftly handles issues of immigration alienation and first love moving and poetically rendered this novel in verse is the story of a young girl whose determination to find out who she is prevails

clueless dogs is the first collection of poetry by rhian edwards already a noted performer of both her songs and poetry this book confirms her startling talent and is shortlisted for the forward prize for best first collection poems like the welshman who couldn't sing chronicle a fraught childhood in bridgend south wales where the sensitive child escapes through imaginative games of playing dead and broken lifeboat full of verve and humour with a spiky syntax featuring hard edged consonants her language has a winning honesty and intensity later poems chronicle teenage lusts student rivalries damaged peers and tense situations although the author doesn't flinch from ruthless depictions in which we are often implicated by her use of the third person you there is an underlying sweetness an elegiac thread most evident in the poems of maturity like back to bed safe the wrong season full of both the sensual rapture of love and a clear eyed realization of its inevitable disappointments witness the poet in performance and it is impossible not to hear her distinctive tones when reading her work clueless dogs is a brave and beautiful first book

this book rewarded me with dark dry chuckles on every page reni eddo lodge hilarious this original approach to discussing race is funny intellectual and timely independent the work of a true mastermind benjamin zephaniah i learned early on that for me as a black professional to rise through the ranks and really attain power i needed to adopt the most ruthless of mindsets possible the mindset of the white man who would tear your cheek from your face before he even considered turning his one first

raphael is a would be author but there have been so many distractions to the novel he has been writing for forty one years that many of the characters have lost patience and gone off to do their own thing but somehow miraculously the novel seems to write itself the frequency of magic traverses an array of lives connected to the village of million hills there s the speculative imagination of luke s travels through mythic landscapes pursued by his nemesis the carnival figure of the great bandit there s the psychological odysseys of the musician a jazz saxophonist and ella an actor both long separated from million hills working their ways across the usa and europe when the paths of these exiles cross a love affair begins time in this richly ambitious novel is both circular and simultaneous but moving as raphael ages towards a sense of dissolution both of persons and of the culture of the village above all there is raphael s belief that in the making of his fiction however messy and disobedient its materials art can both challenge the destructive passage of time and make us see reality afresh
